The EFA is wholly opposed to any form of discrimination against players or would-be players on the grounds of their age, gender, sexual orientation, religion or ethnicity. Disabled persons whose disabilities do not put them at risk of injury should be encouraged to play but it should be noted that there are no specially modified forms of the game to enable more seriously disabled players to participate. It should also be noted that Fives courts are neither numerous nor evenly distributed throughout the country and that the majority of them, being in schools and universities, are not automatically accessible to the general public.
